

We obtained a \$2 million partial settlement. Attorney fees totaled \$800,000.00 and there were \$100,000.00 in expenses. The remainder of the settlement funds, \$1.1 million, was tendered to the clients. We then went on to try the remainder of the case against the remaining parties.

The employees filed suit against a corporation on the grounds that the Corporation breached employment agreements between employees and the company, under which each employee was entitled to 3 1/2% of the proceeds from a 1998 acquisition. The jury found in favor in the employees and awarded them a \$5 million judgment. The Court of Appeals affirmed the judgment. The attorney's fees, after all appeals were resolved, totalled \$2.5 million and expenses totalled \$200,000.00. The remaining proceeds, \$2.5 million plus interest, were tendered to the clients.
